

## **ICAO English Language Proficiency Examination**

### Description

Examination of student in English language skills including Pronunciation, Structure, Vocabulary, Fluency, Comprehension and Interactions, as required by ICAO Doc 9834 – AN/453 for the issuance of English language proficiency certificate.

### Available to

Commercial and private pilots or student pilots of fixed and rotary wing aircraft.

### Package content

Computer based examination with duration of up to 1,5 hours Classroom based exam preparation course with instructor, duration one day. (optional)

### Pre-requisites

Applicants for the examination must: - Have good knowledge of ATC standards and practices - Have knowledge of Operational Procedures regarding aerodromes and airspace - Be sufficiently fluent in the English language.

### Certificate issuance

Students will be awarded a certificate, with a grade of 1 to 6, within seven days of completion of the examination. This certificate should be presented by the student to his or her own aviation authority. On request, and for a fee, VFG will send a certified copy of the certificate to the students' aviation authority on their behalf.

Note. — The Operational Level (Level 4) is the minimum required proficiency level for radiotelephony communication. Levels 1 through 3 describe Pre-elementary, Elementary, and Pre-operational levels of language proficiency, respectively, all of which describe a level of proficiency below the ICAO language proficiency requirement. Levels 5 and 6 describe Extended and Expert levels, at levels of proficiency more advanced than the minimum required Standard. For a full description of assessment level refer to ICAO Doc 9834 Appendix A, Part II, A8 & A9.

### Foreign students

Following approval of student application we will issue a letter of acceptance to the student that can be used for obtaining a VISA from their local Swedish embassy.
